The program committee is soliciting papers describing original research results. Prospective authors are encouraged to submit a one-page abstract in pdf-format. Each accepted abstract will lead to either an oral presentation with discussion or a poster presentation. Moreover, a full paper or the abstract (as chosen by the authors) will appear in the online proceedings with ISBN. Work under review elsewhere can be submitted provided overlap with simultaneously submitted papers is clearly documented.

Awards: The symposium features “*Best Student Paper*” and “*Best Student Presentation*” awards.
Grants: A limited number of grants is available to MSc students with an accepted paper.
